

***Introduction to the
Fuller Scholarship for a Short-Term Mission Trip***

We as a Fuller Scholarship Committee look forward to possibly partnering financially with you as you embark on your mission trip in fulfilling the Great Commission.

Upon the retirement of Dr. Charles Fuller, the Women's Missionary Union (WMU) of First Baptist Church Roanoke set up the Charles and Pat Fuller Scholarship Fund for short-term missions. The fund provides the opportunity for on-going contributions in support of short-term trips as well as scholarships for those who may need some financial assistance. The WMU's intent is to inspire and make possible a greater participation than ever in "doing missions" away from home.

Careful and prayerful consideration will be given to all requests/applications submitted. The Fuller Scholarship committee must screen all requests in light of the overall mission goals of the WMU. The Committee does not wish to stand in the way of any opportunity that will increase the knowledge and vision of the individual. There will be instances, however, when the Committee cannot recommend scholarship support. Obviously, any individual may go on their own, but with the financial support of a scholarship, guidelines will be followed by the Fuller Scholarship Committee. Guidelines
Fuller Scholarship for a Short-Term Mission Trip

Eligibility

1. Applicant must be a Christian and a First Baptist Church Roanoke member in good standing for at least six months prior to scholarship application. Excluded are groups or members of a group for which a scholarship framework already exists.
2. A church member may be a recipient of only one scholarship per 12-month period, either as an individual or as a member of a group.
3. Must be at least 18 years of age by application date.

Specifications / Requirements:

1. A completed Scholarship Application must be submitted. Applicant will also be required to meet with one of the Scholarship Committee members.
2. Application must be submitted no later than six weeks in advance of the trip except in unusual circumstances.
3. Provide a brief personal testimony including how long you have been saved and how you were saved. Include a description of your walk with the Lord since you have been saved. This may be handwritten or typed in a Microsoft Word Document and attached to your Scholarship Application.
4. The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the length, location, and cost of the trip as well as any other factors determined by the Scholarship Committee.
5. For group mission trips sponsored by First Baptist Roanoke, up to \$1,000.00 per trip will be considered.
6. Within one month of your return from the mission trip, please submit a brief report of your mission experience. This may be handwritten or submitted as a Microsoft Word document. There may also be opportunities to share your experiences at a WMU meeting of other group.
